

Bern, the capital city of Switzerland

One of the key objectives of the scout was to determine the location of the church plant. We have a very definitive vision to plant churches across the nation and into the bordering nations, but we had a clear sense to start in the German-speaking part of Switzerland.

Bern:

- 4th largest city in Switzerland
- 2nd largest student population in the German-speaking region.
- Centrally located with quick access to the rest of the country
- Great opportunity for reaching both campus and community





On arrival, we joined a house church gathering and this set the tone for our whole trip.

We went into the Gospel of John and specifically looked at the references to Jesus being the light. This stood out:

"In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it. There was a man sent from God, whose name was John. He came as a witness, to bear witness about the light, that all might believe through Him. He was not the light but came to bear witness about the light. The true light, which gives light to everyone, was coming into the world." - John 1:4-9

This passage was a powerful reminder that in a world searching for light, a true light exists: Jesus Christ.

During our time at the house church, one of the ladies gave us a 5 Francs coin as a prophetic gesture. The inscription on the 5 Francs coin - DOMINUS | PROVIDEBIT - translates to "God will provide."

In their prayer over us they also made this decleration: "We welcome you to Switzerland." And this "welcoming" was what we felt during all of our meetings. An openess and an invitation to come to Switzerland.



During our 10-day journey through Switzerland, we traveled to various regions including Bern, Zurich, St. Gallen, and Lausanne. We were thrilled to witness the hand of God in all of our meetings and encounters, which helped us build strong connections with several local leaders and groups.

Here are some of the highlights of our trip:

- We connected with the leaders at the YWAM base in Lausanne, the leader of Campus for Christ based in Zurich, and the leader of 24/7 prayer overseeing Switzerland. We felt a strong connection with each of these groups and are excited about the opportunity to work together for the sake of the Gospel.
- Bob, an elder in an international church in Bern, opened up time to show us around the city and provided us with insights into the spiritual climate of the area.
- We had the privilege of meeting with John, Markus, and Micha – leaders of different churches. They generously shared their knowledge about the spiritual climate of their cities and the challenges and opportunities they face.
- We were invited to a Thanksgiving dinner with the ICG Christian group in St. Gallen, where we had the chance to hear firsthand experiences and feedback from Christian students on campus.
- Finally, we had many wonderful connections with families inviting us for dinner, individuals meeting for a coffee and just the same spirit of hospitality and "welcoming" into Switzerland.

We are grateful for all of the connections we made and the opportunities that lie ahead for us to work together and spread the Gospel.



"There is a generation of young people waiting for the Gospel."

This is the word I felt, not just for Switzerland, but for Europe. Young people are searching for meaning and purpose - for the light to guide them. There are many false lights, but we have the opportunity to share with them the true light!

Even though evangelism was not a key part of the scout, we managed to have conversations with students about spirituality and the general view students have. We genuinely felt an openness and in some conversations a curiosity.

"The harvest is plentiful!"

There is an immense excitement in our hearts to reach the campuses across Switzerland and the world-class public rail infrastructure makes this such a great possibility. We are dreaming about student-led campus ministries across the nation.



One of the key points in campus ministry is: Reach a student, reach a family.


