# FEDBACK

Our follow up meeting with the **Bern Economic Development Agency** was a big positive. The staff member we set the appointment with unfortunately fell ill the day of our visit, but she set us up with one of her colleagues whom we also met during the March trip. We had 3 hours to talk through different ideas and possible ventures and he was able to give great insight into what could work and where the market might be saturated or the cost to entry might be to high. This has given us a lot to work with and then take the next steps necessary.

We also made some new contacts during this trip with people who have heard about the church plant and would like to be connected in one way or another. Again we are amazed with the people are adding to this journey. How everything fits together we do not know yet, but God is the Masterbuilder and we get to be amazed at what He is doing.

#### **BewegingPlus Bern**

A great part of this mission was to reconnect again with **Thomas Eggenberg** and the **Bewegingplus church in Bern**. We were able to join a Sunday service, were hosted by Thomas and his wife at their home after church, and then join their staff debrief meeting during the week.

Again, this seems to be the church we would connect to during our preparation time. They are such an incredible group of people with a heart for God's Kingdom and also a great heart for the refugees.

We are excited to come alongside them and to see God's Kingdom come over the city of Bern and all of Switzerland.



#### **Campus for Christ Meeting**

One of our main meetings during this trip was to follow up with the leaders from Campus for Christ. We have had conversations about the possibility of being employed with them in Bern. We had about a 2hr interview with them as it is still a process for them and to make sure it also makes sense for them.

They are happy and willing to take the next step in the process. It's not straightforward though, as they still need to show why they would want to employ someone from outside the EU and that process needs to follow an official route.


We are very thankful for this connection and the relationships for CFC already built. Now we take the next step towards seeing if this door opens up!
